

A meeting of the Board of Managers of the E. H. Free Library was held June 7, 1910, with six managers present.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and accepted. The report of the Treas. showing a balance on hand of \$1094.00 was read and accepted.

There was a discussion about having the library lot put in good condition and Mr. C. T. Dayton was appointed as a com. to see Mr. Mott and have him put the lot in a tidy condition.

A motion was made, seconded and carried that the Library be placed under the Board of Regents.

Motion made, seconded and carried that Mrs. Wheelock, Mrs. Mannon and Miss Stinson be appointed a com. to draw up constitution and by-laws.

The report of the Librarian showed that the "Boys' Evening" was better appreciated the past winter than the previous winter, that is, until moving pictures came to town.

Three stereopticon lectures were given during the winter and the boys were much delighted, about forty being present at each lecture. The number of books circulated during the winter was about the same as before.

The managers seemed to think it would be wise to plan something of special interest for the young girls, but nothing definite was decided.

Meeting adjourned on motion.
